

Virtual Reality and PTSD



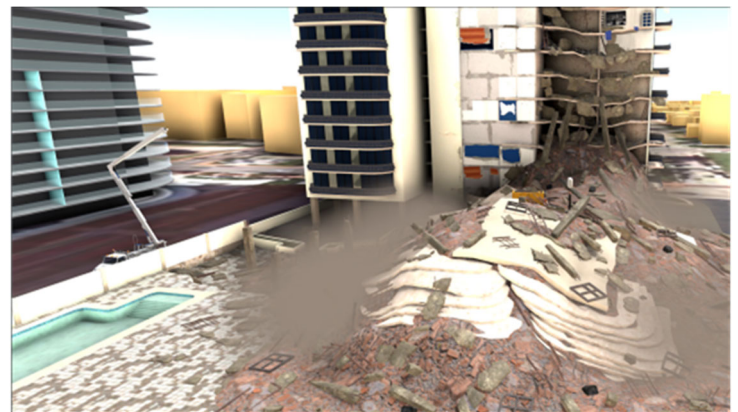
We are testing a new virtual reality system that could enhance treatment for both military and civilian traumas. If you have been diagnosed with PTSD or think you might have PTSD you may be eligible to participate in this research program.

This is an intensive two-week treatment program conducted at the University of Central Florida's UCF RESTORES Center. This treatment program is funded by the Department of Defense and involves Virtual-Reality Exposure Therapy.



This 2-week treatment program includes 10 daily exposure therapy sessions, a posttreatment assessment, and an assessment 3 months after you complete treatment. We expect that you will be in the study for approximately 4-5 months. It is estimated that the total amount of time for all study appointments will be 20-30 hours.

You must be 18 years old or older and qualify for a diagnosis of PTSD to participate in this study.
