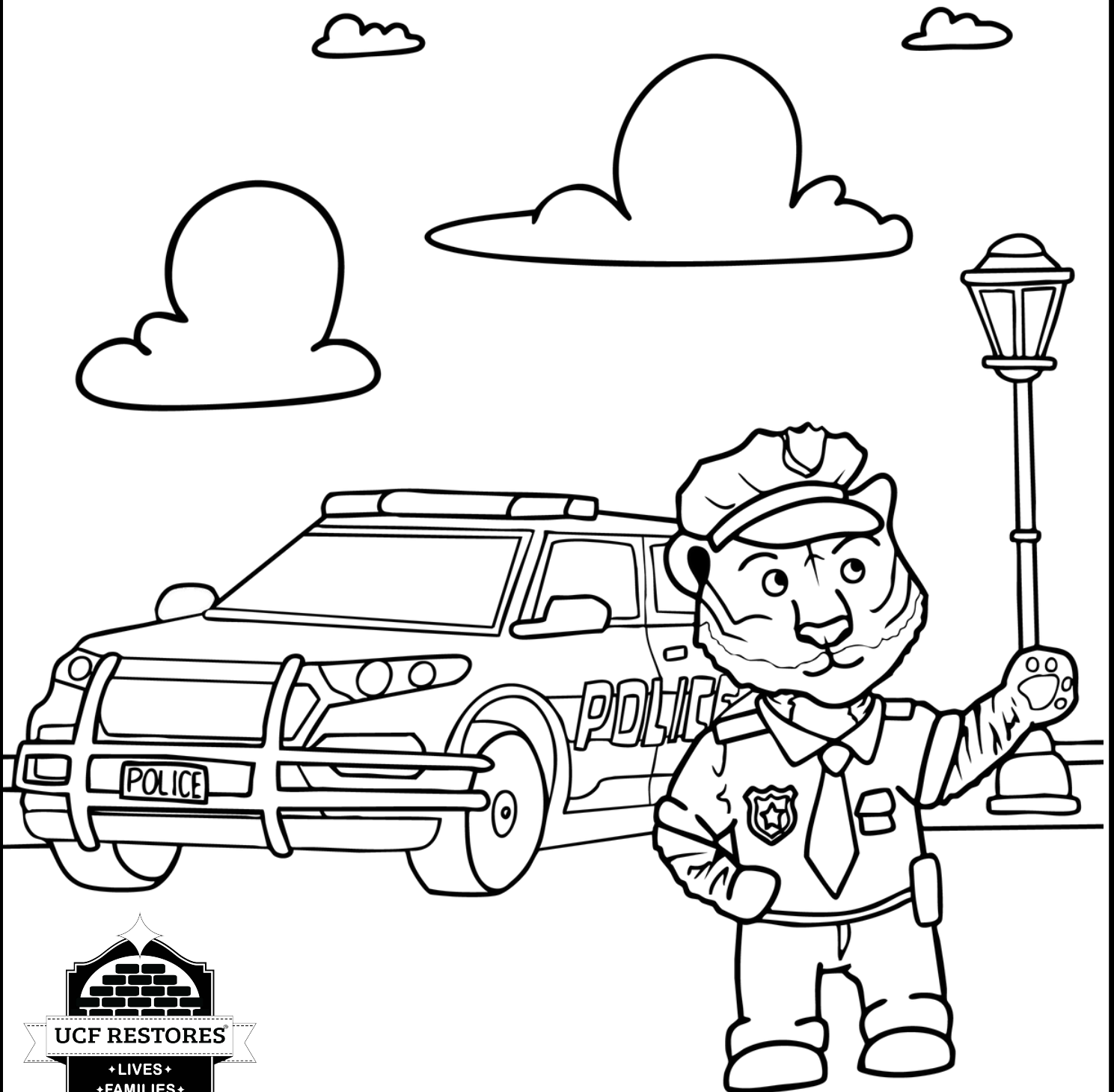
## FAMILY



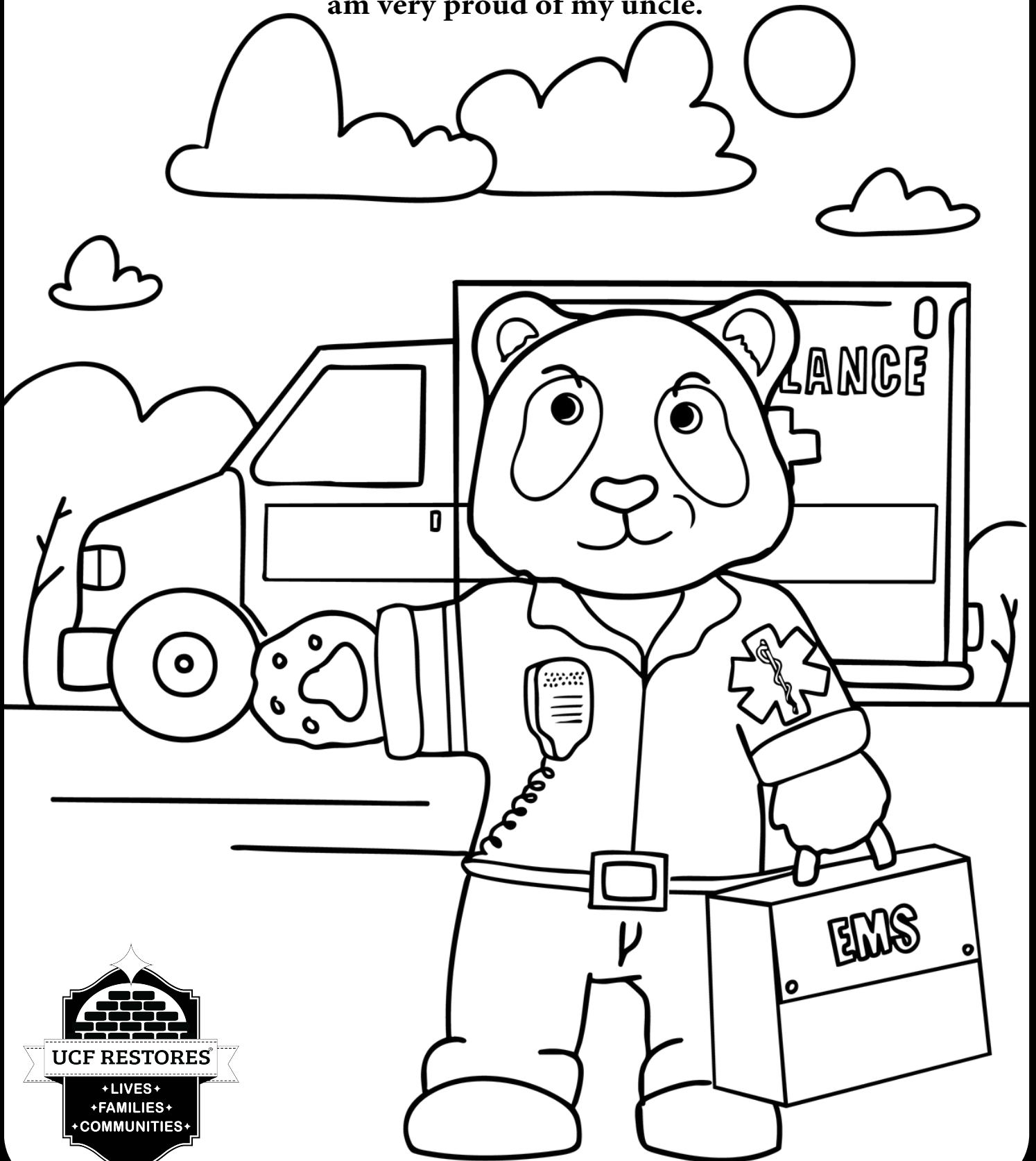

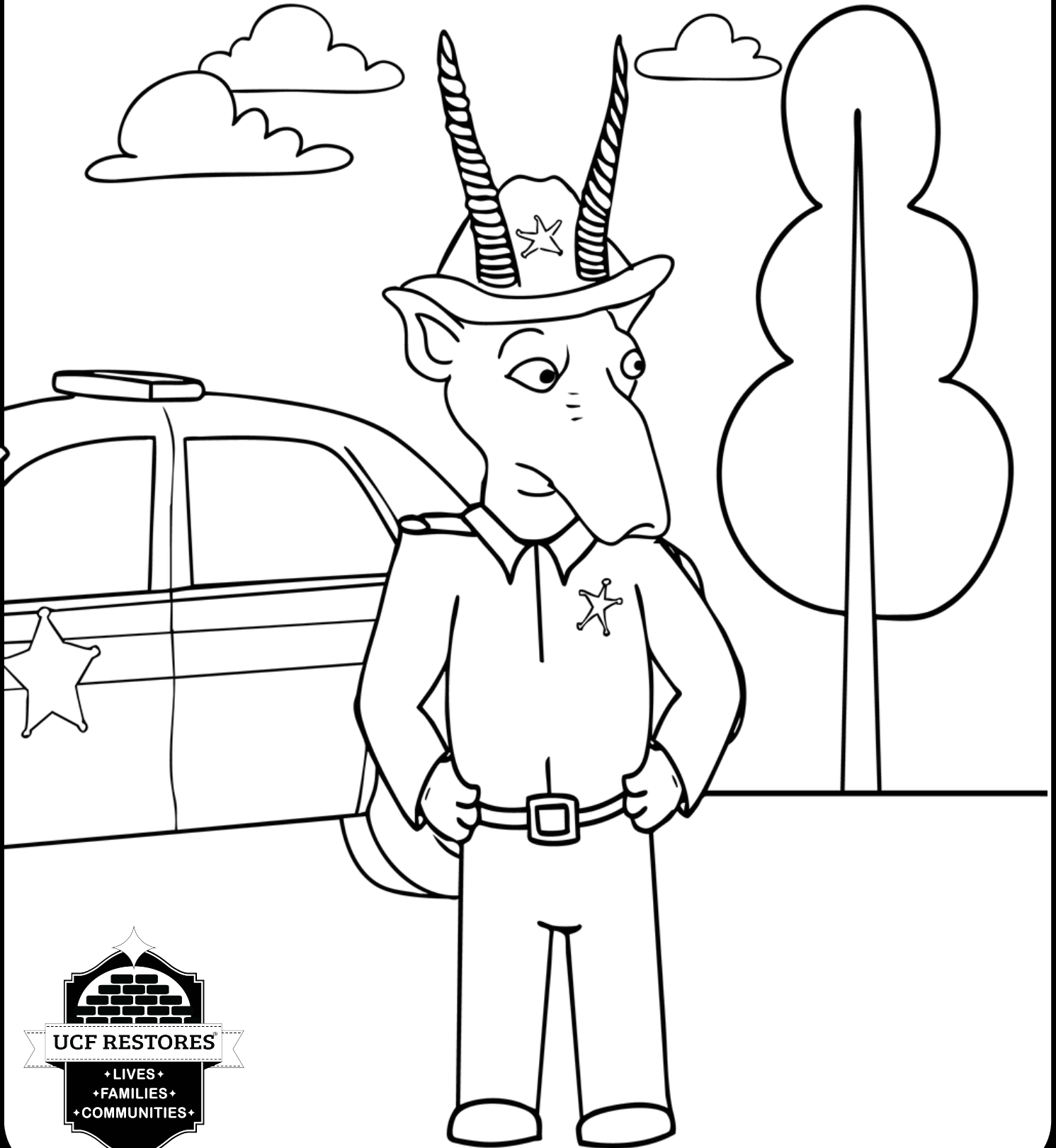
